Homework and how to help your child at home...

Year one PE days are Monday and Friday.

Each week, your child will bring home two books. A new decodable book which matches their phonics knowledge, and a self-chosen, reading for pleasure book that is to be enjoyed with yourselves or other family members. Be sure to engage in conversation with your child about the book they have chosen, asking lots of questions about the story to build their comprehension skills.

Please listen to your child read 3 times per week and record these sessions in their yellow reading records.

Your child will be set a termly homework task for Art, Science, and Spanish, which will be given out on Friday 13th September to be completed by Monday 2nd December 2024.

All homework will be displayed in the school hall on Friday 6th December so be as creative as you can!
